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## Terms

Children's rates apply only when children occupy the same room as their parents.

A \$200 deposit per registered guest is required with the completed registration form to guarantee reservation.

Reservations are based on 7-nights. Refunds are not issued for missed meals, late arrivals, early departures or cancellations.

All final balances are due by June 1, 2022. Please be aware that there is a late fee of \$50 per registered guest for all outstanding balances after that date.

All payments are non-refundable, however, refunds will be issued if, due to COVID19, the state is placed under a mandate by CDC, government or the church.

## Alcohol Policy

Memorial House does not provide or serve alcohol, however it is our responsibility as a Diocese and as people of faith to encourage and promote responsible drinking. Overconsumption is inappropriate and unacceptable.

All applicable federal, state and local laws will be obeyed, including those governing the serving of alcoholic beverages to minors.

Alcohol may never be the primary focus of any event.

When alcohol is being offered during informal social gatherings, it is advisable to serve snack items and non-alcoholic beverages as well.

If the clergy host feels alcohol is being used inappropriately on the property, the host is charged with the responsibility of taking the necessary steps to stop the activity.

The use of other illegal mood altering substances are forbidden.
